

Yeti Giveaway Rules – Official Rules

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** *Yeti Giveaway* ("Contest") is open to legal residents of the United States, who are 18 years of age or older at the time of entry. Employees, contractors, directors and officers of, InRoads Federal Credit Union, ("Sponsor") and their immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and household members, whether related, are not eligible to participate. Void outside the U.S. and where prohibited by law. Subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Participation constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and Sponsor's and judges' decisions, which are final and binding on all matters related to the Contest. Sponsor reserves the right, at any time, to verify eligibility requirements, in any manner it deems appropriate. Void where prohibited.

2. **CONTEST PERIOD:** Contest period begins on or around *August 17, 2026, at or around 10:00:00 AM PST* and ends on or around *September 30, 2026 at or around 05:30:00 PM PST* ("Contest Period"). Entries must be received during the Contest Period to be eligible. The server hosting the Contest application is the official timekeeping device for the Contest.

3. HOW TO ENTER:

- Visit the Orenco Station branch, fill out an entry card, and place in designated container. No purchase necessary. InRoads members and non-members are eligible. InRoads employees, families, and directors are not eligible to win.
- Persons can enter one time per business day when the Orenco Station branch is open. If a person decides to open a membership with InRoads, they will receive an additional 10 entries that day.

By participating, you agree to these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor and the Contest Administrator, which are final and binding in all respects. One entry per person per contest. Use of any automated program or device to enter will result in disqualification. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible or misdirected entries, which will be disqualified.

No assignment, transfer or substitution of the prize is permitted, but Sponsor reserves the right to substitute prize with one of equal or greater value should a prize become unavailable. Prize winner will be solely responsible for all federal, state and/or local taxes associated with the prize. Unclaimed prizes will not be awarded.

7. NOTIFICATION OF WINNER: The potential winner will be notified phone or email on or about *Thursday, October 1, 2026, at or around 10:00AM PST*. Sponsor is not responsible for any changes of email address, mailing address and/or telephone number of entrants.

8. GENERAL CONDITIONS: Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Contest if any fraud, virus or other technical problem corrupts the administration, security, or proper execution of the Contest, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. In the event of cancellation, Sponsor will award the prizes from among eligible entries received prior to cancellation, in accordance with the selection processes described above. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Sponsor is also not responsible for any damage to any participant's computer system/software related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in this Contest.

11. **ARBITRATION/CHOICE OF LAW:** Except where prohibited, entrants agree that (1) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Contest, or any prize awarded, or the determination of the winner shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by arbitration pursuant to the Rules of the American Arbitration Association, then effective, and (2) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Contest but in no event attorney's fees; and (3) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased.
