## Macramé Plant Hangers with Amanda Borges

### MACRAMÉ PLANT HANGER

#### Materials:

- 4mm Macramé Cording - 4 pieces of 96" length cord (2 table lengths)
- Sharp Scissors
- Succulents Faux or Alive
- Spanish Moss or Potting Soil (to fill the pot with)
- 4" Terracotta Pot

#### How to:

1. Fold the 4 cords in half and tie a knot at the top of the fold. Tug on each of the cords to make the knot nice and pretty.
2. Hang it on a knob or hook to begin the process.
3. Take any 2 cords and tie a knot approximately 12-14" down from the top knot. Go all the way around so you will have 4 knots, each made of 2 cords. Make sure they are the same distance down from the top knot.
4. Take 2 adjacent knots and select one cord from each knot. Tie those cords together, about 2" from the first knots. Go around until you have 4 knots, making sure they are the same distance from the first knot.
5. Check to make sure the pot fits. If it does not, adjust the second row of knots.
6. Tie a final knot at the bottom.
7. Fill with Spanish moss or potting soil, add your plant, and enjoy!
