

Flower Arrangements with Aimee Thompson

PUPPY DOG FLOWER ARRANGEMENT

Materials:

- Container, lined with plastic (basket, bucket, pot, etc.)
- Floral foam
- Scissors
- 12-14 White Carnations
- Additional flowers of your choice
- Green ferns
- Ribbon
- 2 eyes (googly, beads, or button) ♦ 1 nose (bead, button, or pom-pom)
- Glue (hot glue or floral glue)
- Pipe cleaners or floral wire

How to:

- 1. Soak the floral foam for 45-60 minutes prior to Creating the arrangement.
- 2. Line the basket with plastic so it does not leak. Cut down the foam to fit the basket and place in basket.
- 3. Add a base of green ferns around the perimeter.
- 4. Begin making the feet of the dog, trim the stalk of the Carnation and build the legs of the dog. This will use approximately 4 flowers. Then add one for the chest area.
- 5. It is easier to make the dogs face in your hand. Put two Carnations at the bottom and one on the top, use a pipe cleaner to hold together.
- 6. Pick a nice full Carnation for the nose/ muzzle and place that at the bottom. Then add two ears at the top. Use a pipe Cleaner to secure and trim ends.
- 7. Add the bundle you have created above the dog's chest. Use a few more flowers



- to build out the chest area.
- 8. Next use some tall flowers in the foam to create height, your choice on how tall.
- 9. Now start building and adding colors into the arrangement. Continuing filling in to your hearts content, keeping the dog the focal point.
- 10. Create a bow of your choice using a special floral wire or a pipe cleaner. Add to the neck of the dog.
- 11. Glue the nose and eyes onto the face. You now have an adorable puppy flower arrangement!
