Top 10 DIY Home Organization and Storage Ideas

SUITCASE SIDE TABLE

Supplies:

- Four 12" round taper table legs
- Four straight top plates
- 16 pan head no. 8 3/8" screws
- Drill
- Phillips 3/8" drill bit
- Spray paint (Used: Rust-Oleum Gloss Protective Enamel, color Army Green)
- Blue masking tape
- Drop cloth
- Black-tip pen

How to:

1. Cover the metal ends and feet of each leg with blue masking tape.
2. Place legs on top of drop cloth and spray paint each one and let dry. Make sure when spray painting to follow all directions on the can and spray in a well-ventilated area.
3. Remove blue masking tape.
4. Turn suitcase upside down and position legs on the corners of the bottom of the suitcase.
5. Hold onto one leg and with black pen, mark dots on the suitcase where the drill holes are located on the leg. Repeat with the other three legs. This will make it easier to attach the legs onto the suitcase.
6. Drill legs into the bottom of the suitcase.
7. Turn suitcase right side up and enjoy your new side table.
