

Top 10 DIY Home Organization and Storage Ideas

WHEELIE WOOD STORAGE CUBE

Supplies:

- 3/4" thick plywood cut into four, 15 1/2" squares
- One piece 15" plywood square
- Wood glue
- Clamps
- 8 x 1-5/8" finish head screws
- Drill and phillips drill bit that is slightly smaller than the screw
- 100 grit sandpaper
- Wood filler
- Wood finish stain, dark walnut
- Paste finishing wax
- Rags
- Four, 2" soft rubber swivel plate casters with side brake
- Twelve, 14 x 3/4 screws

How to:

1. Apply glue around entire edge of the 15" square and lay flat.
2. Apply glue on one edge of each 15 1/2" square.
3. Line up each square around the 15" square base and clamp together.
4. Once glue is dry, remove the clamps.
5. Pre-drill 1" from each corner and one in the center edge of each board. A total of three pre-drilled holes along each edge.
6. With finish head screws, drill into each hole, making sure to sink screws entirely into wood.
7. Add wood filler to cover the screw heads and let dry.
8. Sand away excess wood filler and around the edges of the box, wipe away dust.
9. Apply stain with a rag and remove any excess and let dry for 24 hours.
10. Apply wax, wait 20-25 minutes and buff away excess wax.
11. Drill one caster on each corner of one side of the box.
